Dear Friends,

There is so much that I don't know, so much yet to learn. Sometimes what there is to learn corrects what I thought I already knew. Usually, someone else has to teach me. And almost always, I'm better off for it.

On my recent fishing trip, it was recommended that I bring a fly called a "clouser". It's easy to tie and very durable. But it just doesn't look fishy to me, so I don't fish them. Still, I tied a couple, mostly just to say I did.

On the last day, the guide asked me if I brought any clousers. "A couple," I said. "I'll leave them with you if you like," I continued, hoping he'd pick up on my distinct lack of enthusiasm for using it.



You can see what's coming, can't you? On the very first cast, the biggest fish of the trip absolutely inhaled it. Unfortunately, the fish's sharp teeth cut my line as he did so, leaving with me only the memory of his massiveness.

Suddenly, I wished I had brought more clousers!

Increased knowledge means increased skill and increased skill means increased success. Learning is one of the most important keys to self-improvement. And this leads me to a question: What are you learning in your life right now? Over the years, one of the things I've seen that is the surest recipe for disappointment or worse is to have no intentional ongoing learning process in place. It is to have no deliberate, sought-out course of action to get what we need to become a better person tomorrow than we are today.

Frankly, I know of no better place for this to happen than church. It's where I've found the people most willing to share what they've learned with me. It's where I've found a community that has supported me in putting these learnings into practice. It's where I've found ongoing relationships—many spanning decades—that facilitate the process of improvement (it doesn't happen overnight!) and most importantly, it is where I find the Spirit of God, the power that helps make change possible.

Thank you, St. Matt's, for all you've taught me. I am eternally grateful.
