I could swear it's Pentecost. I'm looking out the dining room window while having a cup of tea, and there it is. A blazing red "tongue" of fire, plain as plain can be, is standing atop its head.

He is not, however, speaking in tongues. Rather, he is using his long beak to eat from one of our suet feeders.

"He" is a pileated woodpecker, a remarkable sight. This is the largest woodpecker in the United States, as big as a crow. They have been called the "real-life Woody the Woodpecker," and the similarity is obvious. I feel deeply blessed to see him.

It's not just him. The backyard is full of beautiful birds, at least 20 different species. There are bluebirds (Holy Cow!), blue jays, house finches, purple finches, cardinals, wrens, a yellow-bellied sapsucker, and many more, all stunners in their own way. What a gift it is to share space with them. It enriches my soul.

And it's not just birds, either. The backyard, like the world, is full of so many gorgeous, fascinating, awe-inspiring things. There are more things to behold and feel our spirit lifted by than we have time to really see. If I spent a whole day simply looking at all that surrounds me, marveling at it, reveling in it, being grateful for it, and worshiping God for it, I'd barely scratch the surface.

I know we are all busy, with much to do. And I know we all carry burdens, things that weigh us down and can cause us grief, sorrow, or anxiety. Sometimes it is hard to see anything else but the challenges and concerns before us. But I truly believe this is never the whole story—and in my experience, it is often the people who have it the hardest who know this the best.

Prayer is the traditional name given to the practice of seeing the bigger picture. **Developing a life rich in prayer is surely one of the most crucial life skills we can pursue in 2025.** Praying together in church is an



essential part of this. When we pray, we take the time to stop, to change our focus, to see the goodness that is always at work around us, and to be grateful for it.

For those of us, such as myself, who understand prayer as communication with a personal Being (God!), it is to say thanks, and in saying thanks, to realize how deeply and securely we are loved. That is a life-changer, believe me.

It is my hope that our 2025 will be filled with the kind of prayer that really does change lives. It has surely changed mine.

Don't just be a spec-tater—dig in!




Join HRTS as we pack 280 bags of food to help kids in need right here in Sterling at 10:30 AM.



Why Failure Is Important

- Rescuing creates dependency. Don't "rescue" your child if he/she is scared or nervous about a situation by sheltering your child from those situations or providing excessive reassurance. This can send the message that you don't believe the child is capable of handling the situation, which may make him/her dependent on you in order to cope.
- Problems lead to problem-solving. For teens, learning to handle difficult situations and decisions is critical. The teen years are a key developmental time when we develop our executive function skills and our human skills, such as our abilities to make decisions, problem-solve, think through problems and regulate emotions. And, we learn not only from success but also from failure. That's why teens need to experience situations where they can make bad decisions, because it's actually how they'll learn to make good decisions.
