Dear Friends,

What is your job as a human being?

I'm not asking about your vocation or career. I am asking what is our responsibility, our fundamental duty, as a person. Would you agree that it is to become a certain type of person? Is our essential obligation in life to become a good person, a loving person, or a productive member of a community who leaves the world better than we found it, for example?

Let's take this a step further. Consider an important role in your life, such as being a parent or a spouse. What is your job in that role? A parent's job, for instance, is surely more than providing food, shelter, and clothing for one's children. I'd suggest it involves actively shaping our children so that they see the value in becoming more like Jesus.

I'd also suggest that these "jobs" are far more important than what we do for a living. And yet it is the norm in our world today for them to receive far less attention.

At St. Matt's this fall, we want to partner with you in these essential activities. I'm tremendously excited about what we are offering this September. One of these things is a brand-new sermon series, "It All Got Better When..." It's going to be an opportunity to think more deeply both about what the most important things we can do are, and about how we can incline the odds towards success in doing them. Frankly, simply taking an hour a week to intentionally focus on these things and duly consider them is invaluable in actually accomplishing them.

We've also hired Ben Merola, as our Interim Youth Minister for our middle and high school students. Ben, a previous summer intern, is looking forward to fun outings to promote fellowship – like Sportrock Climbing on September 4, and spiritual formation on Sunday mornings between the 9:30 and 11:00 AM services.

Faith Factory is also seeing an infusion of new talent as we add two new teachers, Hilary Hultman-Lee and Alex Yarbrough. I hope you'll take a few minutes to read more about them later in this newsletter. If you are the parent of a child ages four fifth grade, I hope you'll bring your children on September 3 at 9:00 AM for a breakfast treat and a chance to meet their new teachers.

That "it takes a village" to raise a child is more than just a trite or clever line; it is simple truth. Whatever their age, we think it is the wise parent who builds the church in as part of their young person's village. It is one more critical component that helps create the favorable outcomes we desire.

From my perspective, this is one of the strongest seasons in ministry we've seen at St. Matthew's. I looking forward to joining you in it.
