COLORFUL COMPANIONS

One of the things I love about our backyard is the... turtles!

Although our entire lot is less than 1/3 of an acre, the turtles that call it home have been there longer than we have- and we've been there 25 years now! New generations join us every year as eggs hatch that were buried in the soft, moist garden earth.

They are eastern box turtles, and they live at least 40 years (some live more than 100!) in fact, they aren't even full grown until they turn 20 years old or so.

If you've seen one, you know how colorful and intricate their shells can be. If you've seen more than one, you also know how much their shells vary from turtle to turtle. That's how we know the individual turtles in our yard. One, for instance, is virtually neon orange.

Not only do we know them, but they also know us. Because I feed them slugs (great pest control!), if they hear my footsteps they will actually come find me expectantly. Surprisingly, box turtles are also great climbers, and so I have found them waiting for me on the deck.

This is but one instance of how indescribably rich animals make our lives. What would we do without them? I could not be more pleased, therefore, that this year we are having **not just one, but TWO Pet Blessings.**

The first will be a short service held in conjunction with the yearly celebration of Saint Francis at Algonkian Park (Shelter 2) on Sunday, October 5th at 5 PM. It's always a great event, and I absolutely love seeing the various pets people bring. I hope you will bring yours!

The second will be blessings offered as part of our annual Trunk or Treat on Sunday, October 19th from 2 PM - 4 PM.

Between the great creativity of the people making trunks, the various costumes, and all our community neighbors that show up, this event is always a blast. It's a lot of fun to attend, and perhaps you even want to host a trunk!

Of course, there is much more happening this month, as this newsletter attests.
