It was a challenging day to be on a jetty sticking well out into the ocean. The rain was constant and cold. The wind howled, relentlessly. But mostly it was the big waves, so big they were breaking over the jetty, that made it not just unpleasant, but treacherous.

The fishing, however, was great.

A huge fish jumped out of one of the waves, its head shaking as it tried to throw the hook at the end of my line. It was the biggest fish of my life.

Only one other person was on the jetty that day, a man I did not know. But when he saw my fishing rod bent double, he came running, stepping out on a big rock to net the fish. Unfortunately, just as he did so a large wave crashed up against the rock. Both fish and man vanished in a sea of violent spray.

Only one reappeared, flopping at my feet. "Damn," the man said, "that was a good fish."

And that was how I met Russ. It was the spring of '95.

We would fish together many times in the years to come, often sharing a meal before or after. His wife had died just before I met him. He was a tough ol' cuss, but it was clear he missed her terribly, suffering awful loneliness.

Russ would go home to New Jersey for the summer, enjoying cooler weather and fishing for striped bass. Upon his return he would call to let me know he was back. This year, however, I could hardly recognize his voice. They had found cancer in his throat. "Let's go fishing," he said.

Though thirty years my elder, Russ always had the energy of six men. But when we met this time he commented, "I move a little slower these days." And he did. He had lost a lot of weight. "Bet you don't even recognize me," he said. But I did.

"Here," he said, taking my hand.
"Feel my neck. Hard as a rock from all that radiation. I still can't really eat. Just keep trying to put down that damn Ensure." We loaded up our gear, and for the first time I can remember he asked for a hand.

We ambled off towards the water, wading out to a beautiful island where we had fished together many times in the past, often well into the night. We talked about life, people we knew... and of course, fishing. During the conversation, Russ mentioned Jesus many times, though mostly by last name, and mostly when he missed or lost a fish. "I want you to do my eulogy," he said.

When we returned to shore, it was he who had caught the biggest fish. "Damn," he said, "It was good fishing together." And it was.

Life can be a pretty poor and insipid thing without people to enjoy it with. I hope this summer we will all make a point of spending time with our friends.

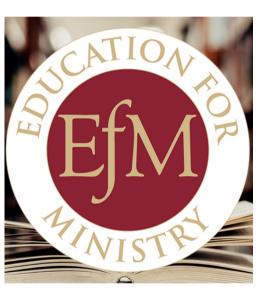
