A few weeks ago, the parent liaison at Park View High School reached out with a special request—three young students were expecting babies and needed support. I passed the message to Kristin, our Outreach Coordinator, and she sent a note to the congregation.

Within hours, the generosity began to pour in. Over the next two weeks, my home turned into a staging area for love in action—Amazon packages arriving daily, families dropping off diapers, baby gear, clothing, and essentials. By the time we delivered everything—four SUV loads—we had collected:

- 4 infant car seats (3 brand new)
- 3 brand new cribs
- 2 baby swings
- 3 strollers (2 brand new)
- Changing table, carriers, blankets, bottles, toys
- 38 onesies and 50+ baby clothes
- Over 700 diapers

It was overwhelming in the best way.

This is why I love St. Matthew's. Years ago, when Fr. Rob arrived, we took a survey asking what kind of church we wanted to be. The answer? A church rooted in Outreach. A church that shows up—and then some.

And that's exactly what you did. You gave, you showed up, and you changed the lives of three young women who now know they are not alone.

Thank you for being an "and then some" church. You continue to remind me what it means to love our neighbors—and to do so with open hearts, open hands, and joy.


