A message from Rev. Mary Margaret Winn, Asst. Rector

Dear Friends,

Mission trips: there are about as many different philosophies about mission work as there are people. But if you have ever been on a mission trip, you know that philosophies matter infinitely less than people do. You can plan and organize and fundraise (and these things are all very important!), but when you get to your destination, you realize it is all about relationships.

I have had the great fortune to go on several mission trips in my life and while they have all varied widely, I walked away with the same feeling-my heart on fire.

It was never the kind of fire that I expected, though. Rather than burning hot and fast, I was startled to discover that each time, I simply gathered embers. I remember having a lunch meeting with my advisor in college after a spring break outreach trip to Jamaica. She asked if my life had been changed, expecting me to respond with an enthusiastic "yes!" Instead, I said "sort of?" Of course I had been moved and shaken by the people I met and the places I went, but I didn't come back with the feeling that I was going to change the world. I came back with hot coals of compassion and questioning and a nagging from God that have continued to burn in my heart ever since. They influence how I move through the world. I know they have been part of my call to ordained ministry.

This kind of fire is exactly what I pray for all of us. While fires that burn hot and fast have their place and are certainly exciting to watch, they can also burn out quickly. What really good mission work does is create embers– relationships that sustain us our whole lives long and drive us to be the best people and Christians we can be.

As you make your plans for this summer, please consider signing up for one of our mission trips. The youth will be headed to Harrisburg, PA June 26-July 2, and adults are headed to Lake Charles, LA July 16 -22 for a variety of community projects and relationship building. These are truly unique opportunities to fuel the fire that God has started in you.

FULLY EXPERIENCE HOLY WEEK

What is Holy Week?

Holy Week is the week leading up to Easter. Experiencing Holy Week is to walk through Jesus' most trying hours and the events that led to his death and ressurection. Walking through this journey allows us to contemplate and embrace the sorrow and then unbelievable joy on Easter morning.

Let's take a brief look at some of the primary observances in Holy Week:

Palm Sunday is the celebration of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. This is the Sunday prior to Easter and will be celebrated by waving palm branches outside and then processing into the sanctuary to hear the Passion.

Tenebrae is Latin for shadows, so this is a service of shadows. In this service we use increasing darkness to dramatize the increasing sadness of Holy Week. The purpose of the service is to recreate the betrayal, abandonment, and agony of the events through music and scripture.


Maundy Thursday (or Holy Thursday) commemorates the Last Supper. Our Maundy Thursday service will include the option to participate in foot washing and then the altar guild will strip the altar – removing all signs of Jesus from the church for observing the days Jesus was dead.

Good Friday observes the day Jesus was crucified. This day is often a day of fasting and prayer. It's the most solemn day of the church year.

Holy Saturday reflects the day Jesus was buried in the tomb. (and you might catch Fr. Rob wearing his 'holey' jean jacket!).

Easter Sunday a celebration of Jesus' resurrection!


