HOPE

KARA LAUGHLIN, SEMINARIAN

Grace and Peace to you, people of St. Matthew's! I am writing to you from my room at Virginia Theological Seminary, where I am thinking of you and wondering about all we will do and learn together in my year as your seminarian. I am also thinking about hope.

Partly, that's because I have many hopes about our time together. Partly it's bringing up thoughts of my home state, Rhode Island, where Hope is the state motto. But mostly I'm thinking of hope because tomorrow I will give a three-minute testimony to my homiletics (Seminary-speak for preaching) class. We have been asked to take a passage of scripture that has been meaningful to us, and to speak "to the hope that is in us."

It's a good question to ponder: What is the hope that is in me? Where does it come from? Where does God reveal that hope in the story of God's people? I'm looking forward to what I know will be a wide variety of responses to these questions.

For my part, I'm planning to talk about Jesus' encounter with the woman at the well in John 4. This is the story where Jesus and his disciples stopped at a well in the middle of the day. The disciples go off to see about some food. Jesus stays behind at a well. When a Samaritan woman comes, he asks her for a drink, and she is astounded. She has plenty of reasons for being astounded, and we will look more deeply into this in October during Wednesday Night Bible Study when we discuss four encounters between Jesus and women in the Gospel of John.

For now, let's just say that Jesus is breaking all kinds of social barriers for the sake of love. In that story, I see Jesus looking deep into the heart of a woman who has been told by everyone around her that she doesn't count. Often when we tell the story, we might say something like, "But Jesus loves her anyway." But I'm not sure that's exactly right. Jesus loves her. Full stop. Jesus doesn't love her in spite of who she is, he loves who she is, in all her imperfections and failures.

I wonder how many of us have felt that if the people we love could see us, really see us, they might find they don't love us as much as they think they do. The story of the woman at the well reminds me that God looks into our hearts and sees all that we are, including our ugliest parts, and the most shameful parts of our story. God sees those parts, and God loves us completely for who we are right now. That is the hope that is in me.

Hope can be a tough sell in our world. If we want reasons to feel hopeless, most of us can bring up one or two things right to mind. But hope teaches us to look for what's good. Hope teaches us to believe that we can be loved. That the world is worth making better.

I wonder, where does your hope come from? Where is God in that hope? What exactly is the hope that is in you? I hope you join me for Wednesday night Bible Study this month so we can explore it together.
