What kind of Christmas do you want to have this year?

It could be the most superficial of holidays, Christmas in name only, a secular celebration of nothing so much as our gross consumption.

It could be a stressful holiday, where we are reminded of family tensions, relational strife, or a lack of satisfying relationships in which we feel terribly alone.

It could be a discouraging holiday, where thoughts and conversations turn to the state of the world and the many challenges before us.

It could be a selfish holiday, in which we think only about our family and enjoying our own luxurious position in life when so many people, even right here in our own community, simply do not have enough.

Or it could be a deeply and profoundly spiritual time that begins with an awareness of God's presence with us, and God's goodness toward us. In this we realize how deeply we are loved, and so rather than using people to get what we don't have, we can give love freely from our fullness.

Will you make room in your heart so that Christmas can be a season filled with joy and laughter, generosity and genuine warmth, and hope and encouragement for all? Our celebrations can enhance our sense of togetherness, uniting beyond our insular family to our larger human family, and letting us feel anew our bonds across time and space with those we love but do not see.

The choice is yours, but it really is a choice. And it is a choice that is being shaped right here, right now.

Our Christmas, whatever it looks like, doesn't just happen. We shape it by what we do or do not do. My point is that it is worth thinking with great intentionality right now about what kind of Christmas we want to have, and then actively working to make it so. We'd love to work with you, and particularly if it is that last choice that you desire, we have a lot to offer. Whether it is our Wednesday night Advent experience, Sunday services designed to help us prepare for Christmas, outreach opportunities, our engaging Christmas services themselves, or one of the many fun activities we have planned. We are working hard to do our part in making sure that we all have a Christmas that is truly merry and bright.


